About our Friendship Services



Independent Age's Friendship Services are designed to reduce loneliness in older people. Our dedicated volunteers offer regular company and conversation to older people, via a regular weekly or fortnightly chat, over the phone or face to face.

Our service is delivered by dedicated volunteers who receive training to understand the many issues older people face. Telephone friendship calls are available across the UK and face to face visits are available in some areas of England, Scotland and Wales.

Is this service right for the older person I support?

Our friendship services are designed for those most in need.

The points below will help you decide if our service will suit the older person you support:

- Are they an older person who will benefit from our services?
- Do they have a health condition which could prevent them from receiving a regular call or visit?
- Will they be able to remember when a visit or call will take place?
- Are they comfortable receiving a regular call or visit?
- Do they know you are making this referral? Are they happy for Independent Age to contact them?
